Continued flock improvement & refinement of genetics has contributed to a lamb marking rate averaging approx 130%, enabling the earlier than usual sale of core breeders with 2-3 years of production still ahead of them. These ewes are perfectly situated to be shorn now, allowing for a quick freshen up off-shears, & an optimum preparation for an early Autumn joining. Ewes are well balanced, impressing in both wool & carcass attributes, & are showcasing the years of breeding refinement, from a well regarded breeder of top quality Merino sheep in the Dunedoo district.
