The wethers are approximately 5 to 18 months old and the youngest were weaned at shearing in May. These wethers should continue to grow out on the right feed. Please note at assessment the following traits were noted: 2 head with dry tails yet to fall off, 5 head with dried purses yet to fall off, 2 undershot jaws, 1 with mild dermatitis and 2 noted with black marks on the mouth.
