Border Leicester sires are from New Armatree and Inverbrackie studs. Rams are selected for high early growth, high fertility & positive carcass traits. Phenotypically rams are selected for deep and broad bodies with good capacity. Home bred Merino dams are classed to the Border Leicester on wool type. Highly recommended line of extremely fertile ewes to be sold over 2 lines of 204 plus 168 sisters weighing 40-46kg.
