At scanning they were scanned pregnant and empty with the scanner noticing "plenty of multiples in the mob" SIL to Valley Vista Poll Dorset blood rams. Buyers please note that the ewes were assessed as a mob not individual lots as per weights. Light Bathurst Burr was noted at assessment on points, poll and jowl, see photos attached. Of the ewes assessed 10 head were noted with light stain around the tail.
