Ewes will commence lambing August to quality low birthweight Springwaters Poll Dorset rams. Scanning rates show 132% in lamb. These ewes all weaned Dorset lamb's last season. The wool quality was very good last year, and the ewes were deemed to be good mothers. 48 Twins and the balance were scanned as singles.
