These steers would be ideal grow out to finish on crop or pasture for the Grass fed market. A small percentage of these steers would be by ONWARD or TINTARA Murray Grey bulls sourced from the Top of the Range Murray Grey sale held in Glenn Innis. They are out of medium to large framed Charolais X cows. TEMANA & CALOONA Charolais Bulls used on the remainder of the cows. All weaners are out of a Silver Murray Grey herd that originated from Mount View Murray Grey Stud at Bendemeer. Introduction of silver bulls sourced annually from WALLAWONG & MUNDALOLA Murray Grey studs were used to focus on temperament, frame & carcass traits for cattle that are naturally easy doing to target either weaner sales or feeder weights. These weaners are standing on good bone and should finish into quality cattle with plenty of shape for the feeder or kill markets.
