Bloodlines include MillahMurrah's Parratrooper P15, Texas ThunderstruckT383 plus Texas, Waitara and Te Mania Angus bulls. Steers with active pink eye were removed at assessment and weaners will be rechecked prior to loading. The temperament of these steers is a feature and they have had extensive handling in and through the yards. They are trained to bunks, hay racks, self feeders and electric fences. These would normally be taken through to feeder weights and are for sale due to the season. Note 2 decks of Angus and Shorthorn cross steers to make 4 decks.
