With medium to large frame they suit to take directly onto feed or to grow out to export feeder weights. The top 30% also have the potential to make good quality future Angus breeders. They were purchased through 2025 and early 2026 for grass finishing in a grass fed program. Purchase date was recorded with approx 4 head purchased in May 2025, 33 in Sept - Nov 2025 and 23 head in Jan 2026. All heifers mouthed at assessment with four x 2 teeth, another four head just about to break 2 teeth and the balance solid milk teeth. Note another 2 decks of similar heifers from this vendor located approx 25km away. Good quality heifers which are still gaining weight and are primed to move ahead quickly on good feed.
