Assessor Comments	A good quality line of Brahman, Brahman Cross and Charolais/Charbray type heifers. good moderate frame and bone throughout the mob with 40% being considered crossbred flatback types, mainly Charolais in influence. These are the vendors cull heifers and as such are the lighter end of the first round weaners however still show good growth potential and are highly regarded with numerous repeat buyers over the years. Out of a moderate to large framed cow herd that is approximately 25% charolais influence predominately Ayr genetics, with 75% brahman being mainly Bungoona and Lyons family bulls with some chatfield brahman influence also. 31hd 144-200kg, 88hd 200-280kg and 7hd 280kg+ (full weight at assessment). Mixed colours being mostly grey with 73hd, 26hd reds and honeys, 15hd Black, 6hd brown, 6hd brindles.
