Bred out of Large Frame, classed "Te Mania" Blood Cows by VGQ "Te Mania" Bulls. Highly Regarded Cattle that are ideal to finish on Grain & all Milk Teeth. Take note of the frame & forward store condition, Steers are probably growing a frame & maintaining condition at present so will explode on better quality feed. All of the Steers were weighed, mouthed & assessed after being in yards for 3 days on Hay & Water. A good portion were already 15 - 20 kg lighter at assessment than when they first came in 3 days ago & a 4% shrink has been applied to their full weights (make your own adjustments). Aldingham has minimal Prickly Acacia in the paddocks the steers came out of. Vendor has another 2 mobs of Lighter Steers in the same sale. *Monday or Tuesday delivery only.*
