Small percentage of higher content steers through the mob still considered flatback types with a cleaner coat and slight crest. 100% blacks with a small percentage of the Santa Cross type steers showing some red colouring through the saddle and 2 x steers with some white on their neck/underline. All steers are HGP Free and where purchased as vendor bred steers and should be lifetime traceable with only one movement to current property recorded. A very tidy weight range from with 100% weighed from 400 to 500 kg with the vast majority between 430 and 480kg, 17 steers 400-429kgs, 78 steers 430-479kgs and 9 steer 480-500kgs (full weights at assessment). 50% of the mob mouthed being mainly milk tooth with 6 just cracking 2 tooth.
