Cows were not mouthed due to inadequate safe handling facilities available however they are still only 4-7 years old so still should be sound. Vendor will fill cows up full of hay and get them off water before transportation in an effort to have them travel well. We all know what the cattle market is doing so here is a chance to either mate to your bulls choice or fatten to medium export cow slaughter weights.
