The heifers were quiet and easy to handle throughout the assessment process, reflecting the temperament and management behind this breeding program. They present in good condition and are carrying their first calves. Joined to Mawarra Angus bulls T247, T523, U212 and U267 from 20 October 2025 through to 15 December 2025, providing a compact 56-day joining period. Pregnancy testing confirms the heifers are safely in calf and due to commence calving from late July through to September 2026.
