These females are genuine breeder cows that have reared a calf every year and continue to perform within a commercial production system. Progeny from this herd are highly regarded by both local and interstate feedlot operators, targeting domestic and export markets. Cows are 3–7 years of age and are age-numbered with visual tags.
