All cows were mouthed at assessment with 38 being good sound mouthed cows, one cow has clearly knocked a middle tooth out, see photos. Note three cows have moderate blue eye scarring in one eye, another cow has slight blue eye scarring in both eyes. Four cows have some rub marks on either their eyes, neck or rump. Please note vendor also has one cow that was PTIC 2 months in calf and is available post sale by negotiation if required by the buyer. She is included in the photos/video and is an Angus cow weighing 491kg and has a good sound mouth.
