They have been on Rennylea blood for approx 12 years and these are genuine breeders heifers, once removed. They are PTIC to LBW Table Top Angus sires (1.3-2.1 BW - refer photos) and due to calve in approx 1 month. Heifers are being retested for buyer reassurance on 04/07, after the assessment is finalised. Preg scanner will age the foetus's where possible with an update to be attached. These heifers were intentionally purchased for breeding and no expense was spared when sourcing, paying above market value at the time. They have been paired with careful sire selection giving them the best chance of rearing a calf. They are only being offered to the market after the season has failed to make a start this year with calving fast approaching. These heifers were a pleasure to handle through the assessment process being settled and calm over the scales. They have maturity, calving at almost 2 years of age and are holding condition well in a tight season. They present as honest moderate framed breeders in top health. Quality Angus heifers with reputable genetics suitable for someone looking to start or add to a herd.
