Assessor Comments	An excellent opportunity to secure 48 quality PTIC Angus heifers, all carrying pure Landfall Angus bloodlines and joined for their second calf. Heifers are due to commence calving in August over an 8 week period and are presented in store to forward store condition. These females originate from the renowned Glenfalloch Station breeding program, where no expense has been spared on genetics. A very well bred line of young females showing plenty of future breeding potential and expected to develop into productive long term cows. Cattle are being offered due to seasonal conditions and surplus to vendor requirements. Temperament should be noted, with only a handful of heifers showing fast or reactive behaviour under pressure. The majority handled well throughout assessment, however this line would be best suited to purchasers with sound cattle handling knowledge and experience.
