This lot represents the portion of Sherwood heifers that had some level of pink eye throughout the tough season. All have healed and no active pinkeye in mob but approx 20 with some form of scar. Please see photos of worst ones. All have some vision out of both eyes. No heifers with two blue eyes. Hazeldean & Te Mania bulls out of Hazeldean/Boco blood cows. Ideal 'low dollar per head' cattle to put away and forget about.
