Steers Ideally suited to go onto crop to be taken through to all Premium Grass fed programmes as no HGP ,antibiotics or grain. Alternatively they would suit domestic feeder job as the DBR cattle are sought after by repeat buyers when normally sold at heavier weights to feed for 100 day programmes. Please note the 5 strs deemed as later cut were kept as bulls and castrated at weaning . One steer noted with slight blight scarring in one eye not considered detrimental.
