They were purchased in early autumn as mixed sex lambs as part of the annual program. They have been separated from their brothers for +6 weeks and were scanned empty for buyer reassurance. They originated from the New England and are out of fine wool ewes by Chain of Ponds Border Leicester rams. They will mature into medium framed ewes that produce a higher valued fine micron xb fleece with the majority presenting white in the wool and with style - refer photos. Realistically reserved for young first cross ewes that will produce a quality fat lamb next year.
