Cows were purchased in February as replacement breeders from Southern Queensland and NSW, due to change of direction in Vendors business they have come to the market. Cows are predominantly medium framed cows with some large and smaller frame in the mob (please note the majority of the lighter weights were mouthed as 4 teeth 2nd calvers) best described as young to middle aged, purchased as 2 - 8 yrs old and of those mouthed all were sound mouth. Cows present in store condition after just weaning a very good weaner and will power ahead on good feed before they calve. Preg Tested 4-8 months with 90% 5-7 months , only a couple at 8 months. Cows are showing signs of lice and would benefit from a drench. Please note a couple of cows had one cloudy eye and some showing buffalo fly rub marks, 2 cows with white udder. There is 525 Red tag Cows in the line and will be sold run out the gate draft of 6x bdoublets and 1 x4 deck lots , Vendor also has 4 decks blue tag sisters and 2 decks coloured sisters this sale.
