They were weighed from 270-424kg after a decent curfew and after having been through the crush 3 times for the day to sort them. As a complete line of mixed sex yearlings they have been averaging around 1kg/hd/day over the last month. They are receiving wheaten hay and have been supplemented Lead up but appear to have had sufficient.
