There was the odd ewe that is showing heavy in lamb at assessment which will be inspected before delivery. In the mob I assessed there was 3 yellow tag ewes, I noticed a couple of ewes with lumps under the skin. 4 brown/grey spots on heads were counted as blacks in the assessment mob 1 ewe with a long tail.
