These one mark Kenny's Creek Blood heifers have reacted well to good seasonal conditions shown through their successful joining. *Buyers please note these heifers have had a big lock up prior to assessment, thus weights in assessment are curfewed weights.* Heifers averaged 370Kg, topping at 404Kg. 1 heifer noted to have small white splash on belly, 1 heifer with a blue eye, 2 heifers with wart, all considered not detrimental to their performance. Heifers have been drenched with Cydectin Pour On. Heifers are 20-21 months of age. A great opportunity to secure an article of young, well bred, one mark breeders, in calf to a low birthweight Speckle Park Bull.
