These cows present in store condition and have been continuously joined to Angus bulls with a 55% PTIC rate being from 5 weeks to 5 months. 4 cows noted to have capped hips and several cows were noted to have old fly bite scarring. Calves are fresh and range from 75Kg to 301kg to average 191kg. A small percentage of these calves have been marked but the remainder haven't been processed, 1 steer noted lump on jaw. 70% of the calves are over 160kg. These cows & calves have been pretreated with Vetmec Injectable & Amitik Plunge Dip at assessment to assist with tick free buyers in the clearing process.
