Long bodied, clean ewes that have been mulesed. One mark, western bred sheep that show a medium to large frame, and will continue to grow and mature. A great opportunity to secure a line of one mark, maiden merino ewes, SIL to the Border Leicester ram for an ideal Spring lambing.
