Buyers please note approx 5 lambs were marked late with tails still present, but have received all health treatments. Wether lambs are out of large framed western bred merino ewes by the Border Leicester ram. Clean opened faced wether lambs. A great opportunity to purchase a line of weighed out, drenched & vaccinated, vendor bred 1X store conditioned wether lambs to continue to grow out and fatten into ideal killable weights over the expected strong spring conditions.
