Eight of the heifers are Red taggers, (4 to 6 months in calf) with only one being a blue tagger (3.5 months in calf) It is the vendors beleif that most of the heifers that are 5-6 months in calf would likely be in calf to one of his homebred Poll Hereford bull while the rest would likely be in calf to a neighbours Speckle Park bull that got in. However no guarentees can be given. Vendor is only 2km from the Leichhardt Highway, one of the major highways that run north/south and heifers may fit in with a backload.
