Assessor Comments	The heifers were drafted on colour and type. One heifer has one eye (but doesn't seem to effect her) and there is slight scaring in 3 other heifers but definitely not detrimental. Since being weighed initially on the 26/7/21, these heifers have gained over .5 kilos a day (see file attached), have improved enormously and will only continue to move forward. They are scanned in-calf to Stud Angus Bulls (Furracabad P173, Moogenilla P224 and P192) which were bulls used on Weemabah's own heifer mob last year with no calving problems. The Pregnancy scan was completed approximately 1.5 months ago so the Heifers should now be 3 - 5.5 months in calf.
