This mob of wethers would suit the processor, trader or genuine wool grower as they have the condition and weight to hang up or are ready to go with a generous fleece on their back. Please note approximately 3 wethers are included that have been recently shorn. Also some in the mob have untipped horn as can be seen in the photos.
