Some of the kids look to have splash of cross in them (please see photos/video). A sample of 81 kids were weighed from 6-22kgs to average 13.7kgs. The kids that weighed down to 6kgs were considered fit to load but it is highly recommended not to load these too tight. Suit restockers looking to get into goats, an industry that has been sailing along very well in recent years.
