Any close to the head horn is either clear of the skin or loose horn with the vast majority poll bred. 1 cow carries excessive long back toes yet no effect to her gate - a big beautiful cow. 1 with a unusual parrot jaw, 4 with fly rub mark, 1 old blue eye, 2 or more with old vaccination lumps, 1 non vendor bred "Eversleigh Droughtmaster" cow & 2 cows with higher Brahman style colour & content. Fantastic cast for age proven breeders - well up in calf and known to produce outstanding progeny.
