PLEASE NOTE. 2 cows have slight blue cloudiness on one of their eyes, one cow does have a capped hip, 1 cow is brindle, a number of cows have lumps on their necks from needle vaccinations. 1 cow has relatively loud raspy breathing although nothing physical was noticed and was able to walk quite a distance when mustered and had no trouble keeping up.
