A pregnancy certificate has been attached to this assessment and show 6 heifers tested greater than 4 months in calf and 22 heifers less than 4 months. Buyers please note that one heifer was noted to have a birth mark and one heifer had small warts around the eyes, however both considered not detrimental.
