Not all lambs are full shedders, approx 10% of the flock gets shorn each year, this is due to the maternal influence in the breed though the percentage shorn is getting less each year. The vendors adult ewes scanned at 150% last year. The vendors have been using Cashmore Park Nudies for 4 years.
