Assessor Comments	Poperty sold - Merino Downs Flock dispersal. 2.5 to 8.5 year classed out Terrick Poll Merino ewes. Approx 90 Poll Merino chance get lambs at foot 1-4 wks given in. Depastured with White Suffolk rams 05.10.21. Merino Downs is typically soft black loamy soil with approx 12% carrying longer overgrown toes as a result of the country and not genetics & 5% carry cheesy gland nodules (no vaccination protocols). Assessed six days after shearing the sheep were healing well with minor shearing cuts or abrasions. 3% with 1 or both ears missing, & approx 5% with enlarged oversize udders. Given time and by delivery I would expect any shearing wounds to be well on the mend or have healed. The ewes are on very good quality feed and are expected to do very well from assessment to delivery - they will only go one way and that is improve on the fresh feed. This is an opportunistic trade mob of ewes with a % of lambs and re depastured. Some ewes are showing their age and suited for a short term trade.
