All wool was inspected at weighing and any major faults removed. 40% assessed and 100% weighed. Ewes present very even as a group and stand in predominately forward condition and ready for joining if required. These ewes are bred from a highly regarded local flock with very good wool cut. Flock average is 7.5-8kg and 20-20.5 micron as a flock. Ewes will mature in genuine large frame heavy cutting females with good fertility if given the right opportunities. Ewes will be equally suited self replacing merino enterprise or terminal if desired. Please note 3% of ewes assessed carried horn or scur.
