AT ASSESSMENT 1 BRINDLES AND 2 BLACKS WERE OBSERVED. IN THE MOB THERE IS 2 WITH SOME HORN FROM POOR DEHORNING BUT OVERALL THE GROUP EXPRESSES A WELL DEHORNED/POLLLED MOB. THESE STEERS WOULD IDEALY SUIT SLAUGHTER/FEEDER OR LIVE EXPORT AFTER A PERIOD ON GOOD PASTURE. THE FRAME SIZE OF THESE STEERS ON AVERAGE WILL LEND TO GREAT WEIGHT GAIN ON GOOD PASTURE.
