To fit in with most yard requirements the steers were treated with their first Bovilis MH + IBR shot and are timed ready to receive their second by delivery and induction. Please note extended delivery given in assessment to suit your induction requirements. As we are now heading towards the end of the year we have given a three week lift if you would like to have these feeders staged for an induction over the Christmas period.
