Whilst this is an impressive line of majority red & honey steers there is a small tail end in quality, with lighter bone displaying some minor confirmation faults however, still describe as fair quality for this small portion. Medium/ large frames with plenty of capacity to grow into heavy carcass steers. Buyer pays dip for first attempt, vendor covers thereafter if required. Steers are good temperament.
