THE MOB IS COMPRISED OF 38 POLLED HIEFERS, 22 HAVE BEEN DEHORND LATER IN LIFE AND HAVE A HORN BUTT ON THE SIDE OF HEAD AND THE REMAINDER HAVE BEEN DEHORND AS WEANERS.
