Mature ewes lambing 152 % at marking 2021 Maiden ewe lambs joined at 7 months lambing % 132 at marking All ewes retained for past 5 generations are all from twin mothers . Ewes are run at high stockings rates to produce high numbers of Lambs weaned/hectare. Rams purchase are in top 2% for breed with a focus on fertility and early growth. This is an excellent opportunity to add terrific genetics to your program. Odd orange NLIS tag in ewe lambs as vendor ram out of this seasons yellow tags.
