Proven mothers with each ewe successfully scanned in lamb last season, with a mob average of 160%. These ewes were shorn in mid November receiving Avenge + Fly and Avomec drench at shearing. Average 0.5" of wool length. Predominately medium frame with a percentage being large frame. 79% of the mob are 2018 drop ewes with 21% being 2017 drop. A great opportunity to secure a line of Border Leicester X Merino ewes bound to continue producing desirable 2X progeny with plenty of time ahead of these ewes. A small tail was removed from the mob.
