Steers are plainer than the heifers (not unusual) but look to be really on the do and show pretty good weight for age. Noted approx. 1 with a needle lump on the neck, don't think they will be an issue though. These were all mouthed and the No0's are 2-tooths and another steer was mouthed as a 4-tooth but couldn't really identify his age brand. They will scratch clean on farm so won't get held up at the dip. Please be aware there are three lots of heifers and two lots of steers from this property in the sale.
