There are 3 white Brahman heifers in the mob, the vendor will offer them with the option to leave the 3 white Brahman in or out of the sale if anyone is interested in just the red and coloured heifers. Some of the dehorned heifers are showing small amounts of regrowth. One heifer has horns that have been tipped. One heifer has some fly bite marks over her shoulders at assessment. There is one heifer in the mob that has a white face & 4 heifers that are tan or slightly black in colour. Don't miss a great line of pregnant Brahman heifers that are good to handle.
