Heifers received 2 booster shots of 7in1 within 6 weeks of each treatment early last year. The 'Wollumbi' cow herd are consistently 650-700kg mature females that are extremely productive, also reaching feeder weights in calves at 10-12 months of age. The Pollard Family have been breeding Angus cattle for over 30 years, a unique opportunity to source well bred heifers from a highly regarded Herd.
