Temperament is not thought to be an issue with these cows and the calves were exceptionally quiet, sensible and good to handle.

The 2 non detectable cows had access to the bull until assessment and is every chance are in the early stages of pregnancy as well. Vendor has just changed from a commercial herd to being a registered stud and is looking to keep more replacement heifers so these commercial breeders are on the market to make room. Please note, 1 cow has slight cloudy eye, and 3 cows have rub marks around eyes from flies, neither of which is deemed detrimental. 1 steer calf is missing the brush off his tail.
