Assessor Comments	A good to very good quality line of yard weaner heifers. They are medium to large frame and suit to background to heavy domestic feeder weights and then finish for a range of high quality slaughter markets. No heifers are being retained and the top 30% would suit to grow out and select as future breeders. After this property was purchased in 2021, these calves were purchased as part of various mobs of cow and calf units. The heaviest 13 head (over 280kg) were vet preg tested NDP the day before assessment as they could have had access to bulls while on the cows. They were yard weaned on 19/03/22 and are educated to hay racks and electric fences. One heifer has a slight smokey blue eye in one eye and two with a slight BE spot in one eye. While no active pink eye was observed in the mob at assessment, all weaners will be rechecked for active pink eye prior to delivery. They had a LWR or 198 - 384 kg at assessment with a tail under 195kg removed. Please note 33 steers to make a B Dble.
