They have been running on native pastures including young medics & clovers. These steers were quiet & easily handled in yards, with obviously the occasional one becoming upset on scales or in crush (quickly calming). These steers have recently been dehorned & noticed the occasional steer had bump scab at assessment, wouldn't consider it detrimental. All eyes on these steers appeared to be fine at assessment. I will also scan these steers at delivery & a third party transfer will be done for NLIS at no charge.
