	Heifers were generally very good to handle in portable yards. Most did resent being mouthed but that is a natural reaction

with almost all cattle. They did exit the crush reasonably calmly and most settled when back in the mob. There were 2 heifers slightly stirry when back in the mob and did resent us being in their flight zone so there was a little bit of tail flicking etc. Definitely not stirry though.

Assessor Comments	Buyers a small lot of good quality Shorthorn yearling heifers. These heifers show adequate weight for age and are ready to go to the bulls of choice. Please note these were exposed to a neighbours Angus bull for 5 days and if this is a problem for any potential buyers the vendor is happy to inject them with a shot of Prostaglandin at delivery. These heifers show enough fat coverage and most have enough weight to fit domestic grassfed slaughter markets as they stand. There are a couple that do have some uneven fat coverage around the tail head, common with the breed. Please be aware there are 4 lots of heifers from this property in the sale that can be used to fill up a load.
